Already in the second Prelude the 21-year-old Messiaen is trying out the effect of a visionary, aspiring melody over the top of a solemn chorale – the master organ improviser at a very early stage of development (he had not even set eyes on an organ manual until three years earlier).

In the eighth and final prelude, we discover Messiaen, the virtuoso pianist, and a section that, at its most significant moment, is brimming with joy. There is a brilliance that radiates from this prelude like none of the others. The influence of Ravel is ever-present, but the final flourishing gesture is undeniably Messianic.

On the one hand, organist and Messiaen performer Olivier Latry suggested that Messiaen composed the Prélude when he was an organ student at the Paris Conservatory, as it was one of the few places where he could play an unusually large organ with a keyboard extending to C6 (61 notes) and a pedal board extending to G4 (32 notes).
